





 South Kingstown School District is located in a seaside community that is committed to supporting all students to explore their passions and become productive members of their school and town. As a forward thinking school district, we provide programs that place our students ahead of others due to the collaboration among stakeholders and the resources available.

In our district, as in our community, we are comprised of a diverse population of students. With the University of Rhode Island located in our town, many of the visiting professors from many different countries enroll their children in our schools. One percent of our students are English Language Learners and many of those students are members of our schools for a short period of time. The percentage of students who live in poverty attending our schools is seventeen percent and many of them attend our Title I schools. Our overall percentage of students with disabilities is thirteen percent. This percentage is due to a thriving Response to Intervention program at all levels that has assisted early on with explicit and targeted instruction proven to be beneficial with closing achievement gaps for all learners.

Our district has worked diligently to build a curriculum that spans K-12 education. We have partnered with Columbia Teachers College Reading and Writing Project to develop students who love to read and write. Our STEAM pathway begins in kindergarten and expands to the high school with a Computer Science CTE program. We have a strong World Language Curriculum starting in kindergarten with Dual Language Immersion or a Spanish Itinerant extending into the middle school where students can take a high school level language course and then to Advanced Placement classes at the high school. The South Kingstown District strives to develop experiences that will personalize the learning for each student.






